Some of the services are now carried out by the Social ward Department, and were transferred to this Department, when a part-time Welfare officer, and later a Social wasser, were appointed. One graip was formed to promote setucies to children who were hopitalised. This group was alle to

sopand its activities with the appointment of a teacher, initially pait time then subsequently full-time eralling the duilder to continue with their education. This facility was tilesed by the college of advanced Education, with students attending for practical expensive. as the aprital no longer acconnodates major paediatie cases this group had lien phased out. a Day base bentie was established thatening for long-tern inpatients and autpatients who deeded some form of activity. His groups would attend on a specific day and conduct craft and games activitie. With the aduent of the geniature assessment and Rehabilitation Unit, this quarp now cates for a 23 hed mit day patients, with similar activitie to those when the group connerced. Lus groups have been formed to assist Staff latter thanpatients. The Leaver group was formed to relieve the Dursing Staff of the patient floured. The bhart yours indertakes the tasks of assentition the recessary medical Records Sudets used when a patient is admitted to hopital so that the chart is already assembled and available for use when the patients present to the ward. Unifacturately, it seens that not all patients fueld appreciate the services provided by the Voluntary workers, despite the fact that some services are of a personal nature. Sources, it is considered that there will always he a need for udentary markers within the hospital situation and especially in new of

an ageing population. His is an area where there will be a greater red for udurtary help, to support trained personnel warsing in this specialty.
